The "Jaguar Zone" behaviors targeted at school can be applied to other settings. Many families ask for ideas on connecting this approach to home. Below are examples of a "home" matrix, using language common to what is used at school.

#### **RESPECTFUL at HOME**

- Follow directions the first time
- Be kind to your neighbors
- Use a kind voice and good manners

#### **ENGAGED at HOME**

- Help with jobs/chores
- Listen to my parents
- Pack materials at night for the next day

#### **DETERMINED at HOME**

- Get up and ready to get to school when called
- Complete homework
- "If at first you don't succeed, try again"
